<解答例 1>

(62 words)

I think the custom of key money should be abolished. In the past, landlords had a close relationship with tenants and often helped them in times of trouble. But the times have completely changed. These days, most tenants don't even have a chance to meet their landlord, so there's no longer any justification for key money. (56 words)

<解答例 2>

I think the custom of key money should be abandoned as soon as possible. The custom was introduced many years ago when it was still difficult to find an apartment to rent owing to a housing shortage. However, times have changed and the housing supply has been greatly expanded. So, there is no longer need to pay extra money as a token of gratitude.

<解答例 3>

“Behind the times” is a mild way of describing key money. It is practically feudalistic, and totally without merit. It colors the entire relationship between the owner and the renter, putting the latter in a subservient position instead of equal partner in the business relationship. Everyone I know who pays key money resents it, and not just at the time of lease renewal! (63 words)
